KEEP PETS SAFE THIS 4TH OF JULY!





MAKE SURE YOUR PETS HAVE ID

Double-check that your pets' microchips are **registered**. We often scan pets who have microchips, but the microchips do not have any information entered! Check that the information is **up-to-date** and make sure that they're wearing a collar with your contact information on it, **even when they are inside**.



KEEP PETS INDOORS

Keep your pets inside. **Do not leave pets outside unattended, even in fenced yards, or alone inside cars.** Do not take them to fireworks displays or parties.

STAY WITH YOUR PETS



If possible, stay home with your pets. If that isn't possible, consider boarding them for the holiday at a secure facility. If you are just leaving for a few hours, make sure they are in an **escape-proof** room or crate. (Remember that pets have **broken windows** and **opened doors** before to flee when panicking!)



TAKE YOUR PET'S PHOTO

Make sure you have **clear**, **well-lit photos** of your pet so it's easier to identify them in case they go missing.



TALK TO YOUR VET

If you know that your pet is distressed by loud noises, **call your vet** today to talk about medication options.
