



PETS FOR VETS ACT

WAIVED DOG & CAT ADOPTION FEES FOR CA VETERANS

Veterans interested in adopting a dog or cat from California public animal shelters are now eligible for waived adoption fees through the [Pets for Vets Act](#) – a win for both veterans seeking companion animals and shelter pets in need of a home.

The new law became effective Jan. 1, 2020 and prohibits any California public shelter from charging an adoption fee for a dog or cat to individuals who present eligible identification in the form of a valid driver's license or ID card with the word "VETERAN" printed on its face. Although the bill waives adoption fees, licensing and other fees may apply depending on the shelter. The bill also limits the number of dogs and cats adopted from that public animal shelter by an eligible veteran to one dog and cat each six month period.
